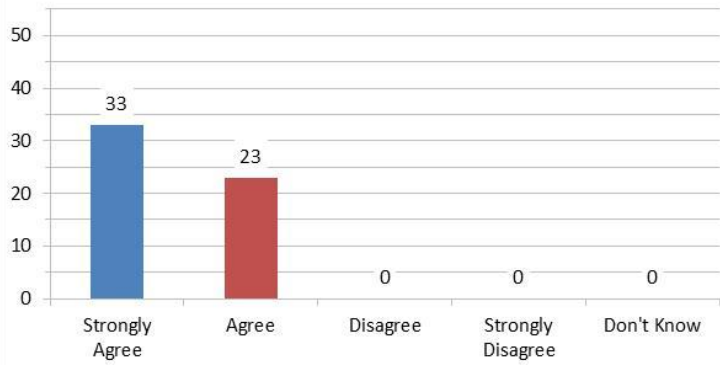


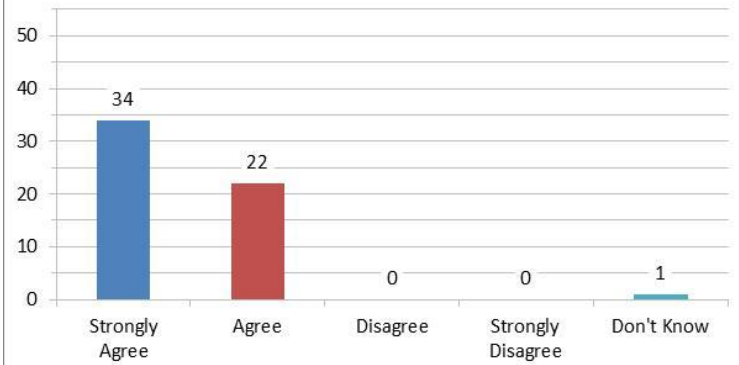

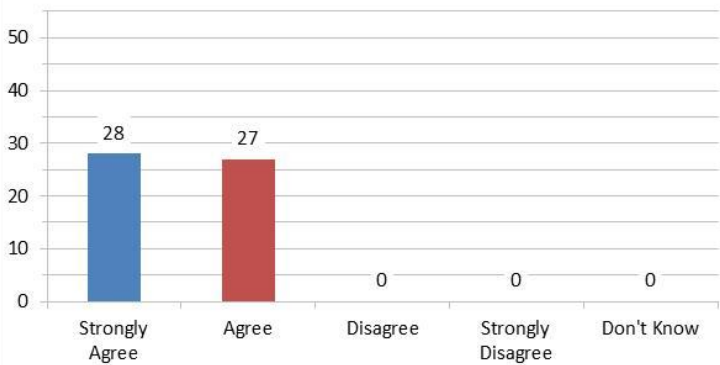
**1. My child is happy at this school**



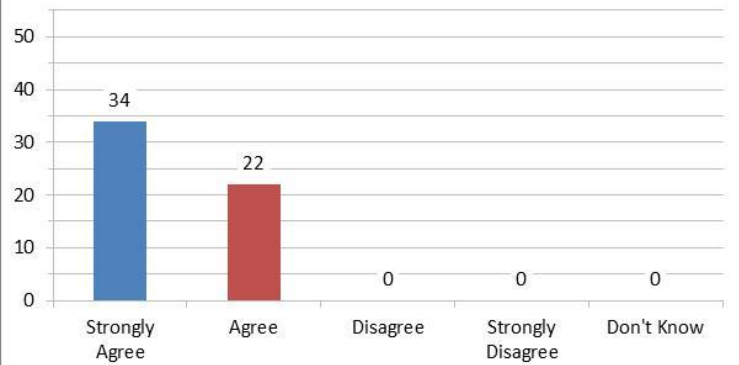
**2. My child feels safe at this school**



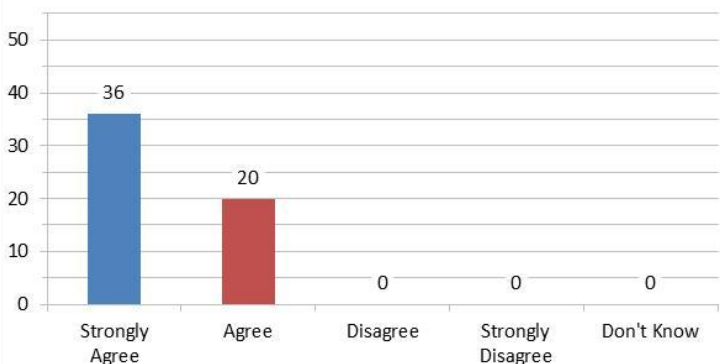
**3. My child makes good progress at this school**



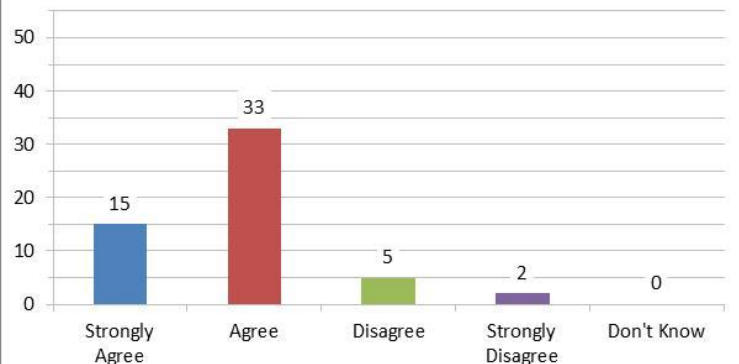
**4. My child is well looked after at this school**



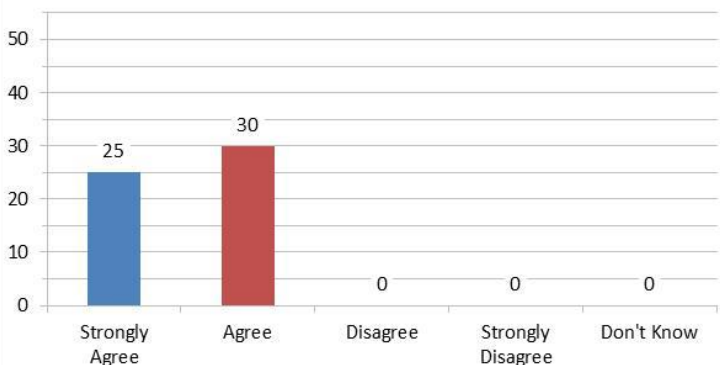
**5. My child is taught well at this school**



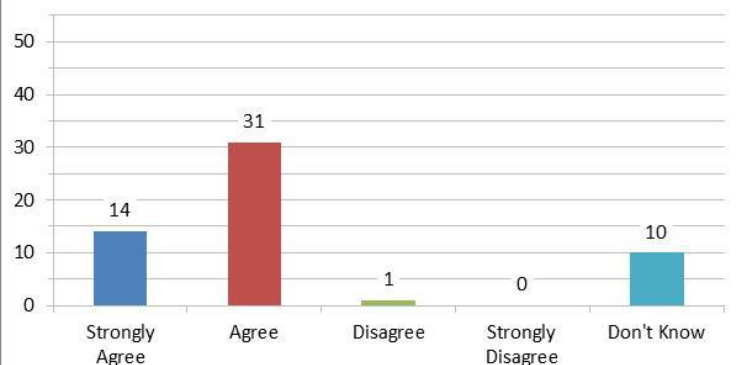
**6. My child gets appropriate homework for their age**



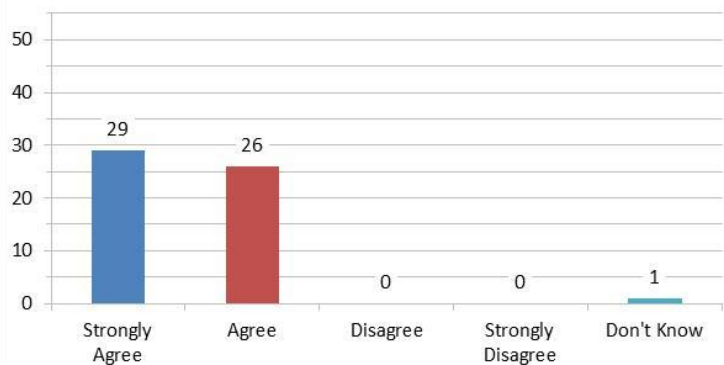
**7. This school makes sure its pupils are well behaved**



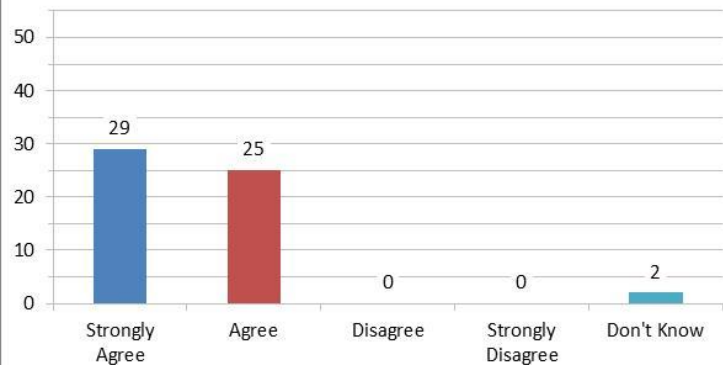
**8. This school deals effectively with bullying**



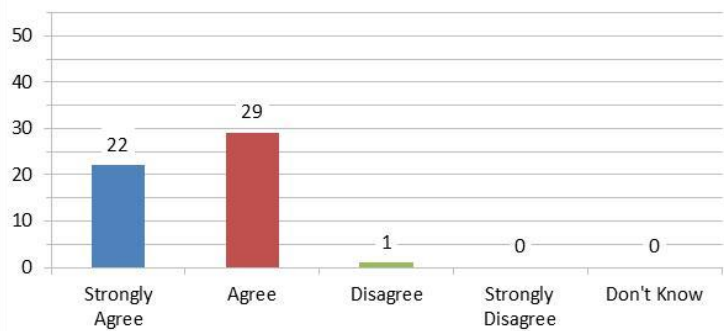

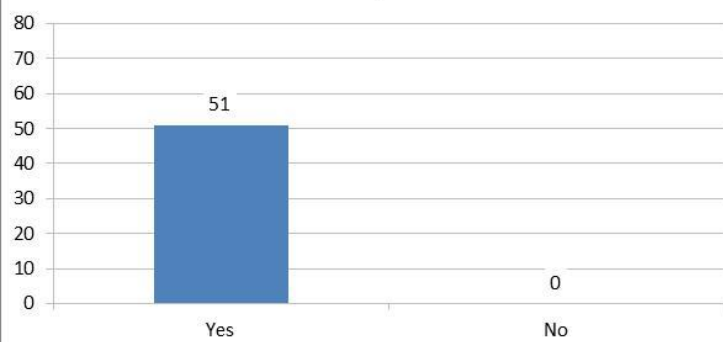

#### **Additional Comments:**

- I find that [my son] does not seem to get much homework. His sister is in Year 8 and gets a lot by comparison. I did wonder if he wasn't doing it but I've had nothing from the teachers and his reports are good. I'm not sure what the homework level should be. We do check Show My Homework but there is never much on there.

*Response from school: We are currently looking at the issue of homework. The level of homework set depends on each subject, but details can be found on the school's website under Parents/Homework.*
- More advice on revision, preparation, expectations and homework.
- I sometimes feel that [my son] gets lots of homework some days and very little on other days. Often it seems levelled out but occasionally I think the teachers could talk to each other and discuss which days they will be setting large amounts of homework.

*Response from school: Unfortunately, there will be times when pupils appear to get lots of homework, especially if there are deadlines for controlled assessments. As we have over 60 teachers, it would be impossible for us to liaise with each other about when we set homework, but we are currently looking at the issue of homework within school.*
- [My daughter's] parents evening was very pleasing. I am happy with her progress in lessons.
- [My daughter] has settled well into Parklands and has continued to work well and achieve her targets. Parklands supports her to enable her to achieve and continue achieving.
- Would have been good if my youngest daughter was given a place at the school (as a sibling) rather than having to go through the appeal process.
- Really pleased with how [my daughter] has settled into high school and is clearly enjoying the experience both academically and with extra-curricular activities.
- Very fortunate that we have chosen Parklands. Extremely grateful for support I and [my son] received from Mrs Fairhurst. Can't thank all [my son's] teachers enough.
- My son has been encouraged to aspire for higher targets and this I feel has improved his self-belief and confidence, and so he has applied for a senior prefect status. SEN have supported him fully and investigated his access arrangements for his dyslexia. This again has given him confidence and belief he can achieve and relieved the exam pressure. He loves the House system, has been proud to be a member of Europe to support Mrs Fox and his form tutor, Miss Greaves. I feel it has given him a sense of purpose, identity and encouraged him to be involved in a community. I feel he would be a good ambassador to share with younger pupils and primary children to shout from the roof tops what a great school Parklands is.
